**Aylesworth Park Authority Solicits Input from  
Archbald Residents**

**ARCHBALD, PA, April 30, 2008**— Residents of Archbald can voice their opinions on what recreational activities they would like to see at the future “Pocket Park” on the corner of Church Street and Salem Road. The site was formerly home to Archbald High School.

Aylesworth Park Authority is taking the lead in the redevelopment of the site into a passive recreational area. The Authority has placed User Questionnaire forms at specific locations throughout the borough to solicit opinions from the borough residents. Interested residents can obtain a form at the following locations:
